





### **ROAD FUNDING**


### WHAT IS IT?

"A 1% local sales and use tax used to fund specific capital projects such as roads, bridges, public facilities, recreation facilities, and water and sewer projects." (SC Department of Revenue)





### WHERE IS IT USED? Active programs in 22 counties





### HOW DOES THE TAX WORK?

- Imposed by County Council
- Decided by voters in General Election
- If passed, collections start following May 1
- Collected by SC Department of Revenue

### HOW DOES THE TAX WORK?

- Imposed by County Council
- Decided by voters in General Election
- If passed, collections start following May 1
- Collected by SC Department of Revenue

### HOW IS THE TAX APPLIED?

- Charged only within Greenville County
- Collected for up to 8 years (in 2-year increments)
- Used only for projects listed on ballot
- Excludes unprepared food, medication, and fuel

### WHAT ARE CAPITAL PROJECTS?

- Highways
- Roads
- Streets
- Bridges
- Parking garages
- Cultural, recreational and historic facilities
- Civic buildings
- Water and sewer projects
- Flood control and stormwater projects
- Beach renourishment
- Dredging projects



HOW IS A CAPITAL PROJECTS SALES TAX INITIATED?

- 6-member commission is required
- Commissioners must be county residents
- County must appoint 3 commissioners
- Municipalities must appoint 3 commissioners (subject to statutory formula)







### WHAT DOES THE COMMISSION DO?

- Considers proposals for funding projects
- Formulates ballot question
- Submits ballot question to County Council

S.C. Code § 320(C): "The commission created pursuant to this section must consider proposals for funding capital projects within the county area. The commission then formulates the referendum question that is to appear on the ballot pursuant to Section 4-10-330(D)."



### WHAT HAS COUNTY COUNCIL ASKED **THE COMMISSION TO DO?**

- Hold first meeting by April 8
- Choose a Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary
- Conduct further meetings as needed to develop the referendum question
- Approve the referendum question through a resolution and send it to County Council by May 31, 2024





### WHAT HAS COUNTY COUNCIL ASKED **THE COMMISSION TO DO?**

- Provide County Council with a ballot question focused on projects to improve roads, bridges and related infrastructure
- Consider projects throughout Greenville County
- Consider projects under jurisdiction of the County, SCDOT, and Cities of Fountain Inn, Greenville, Greer, Mauldin, Simpsonville, and Travelers Rest
- Utilize an 8-year timeframe
- Focus on providing safe and reliable roads







### HOW WILL THE COMMISSION CONSIDER PROPOSALS?

- Staff will present a joint proposal
- Projects will include roads, bridges, and related infrastructure
- Projects will be located throughout Greenville County
- Projects will include County, State, and City roads
- Project list will be extensive enough for an 8-year tax
- Staff will conduct community meetings
- Commission may make adjustments to proposal
- Commission-approved proposal becomes "Project List"





### HOW WILL THE COMMISSION FORMULATE **A BALLOT QUESTION?**

- Follow state law form of question:
  - Years (duration)
  - Purposes (projects)
  - Estimated costs



### HOW WILL THE COMMISSION FORMULATE **A BALLOT QUESTION?**

- The referendum question to be on the ballot must read substantially as follows:

### **IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE THE COMMISSION** HAS TO DO?

- Identifies conditions on use of the 1% sales tax
- Outlines how funds from the capital projects sales tax can be used:
  - •Can specify that sales tax funds can be spent on procurement, design, engineering, right-of-way acquisition, project management, construction, and improvement of highways, roads, bridges, and related drainage infrastructure
  - Can make priority of projects a condition
  - Can build in flexibility to address unforeseen circumstances





### THE COMMISSION IS A "PUBLIC BODY." WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

- Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) applies:
- Meetings are open to the public
- Meeting = quorum (majority)
- Notice
- Minutes
